Take your club's service to the next level — quickly. The Kiwanis Launchpad is new for the 2022 Kiwanis International Convention. The three speakers in each round-robin session will get to the point quickly because they'll only have 15 minutes on the stage. The Kiwanis Launchpads are included in virtual and in-person registration options.

ELC REGISTRATION QUALIFIES AS AN EDUCATIONAL EXPENSE

Clubs can pay all or a portion of each member's expenses for the Kiwanis Education and Leadership Conference — part of the Kiwanis International convention — from its service account. The increased educational tracks offered at the 2022 Kiwanis International Convention meet the requirements of educational expenses allowed to be deducted from a club's service account.

Covered expenses can include: Registration fees up to US\$299, hotel, airfare or mileage, meals, per diem and other expenses as determined by the club. If a club chooses, a fair practice could be to provide two-thirds of any reimbursement from the community service account and one-third from the administrative account for a member attending all three days.

Expenses related to a member attending only the Kiwanis Annual Meeting do not qualify for reimbursement from the community service account by Kiwanis standards. Clubs may continue to cover any portion of members' convention expenses from their administrative account.
